We are a world leader in recycling and have set an ambitious goal of recovering 55 percent of all the paper and paperboard consumed in the U.S. by 2012.

The forest and paper industry, while providing society with wood and paper products vital to everyday life, also meets the expectations of Americans by serving as responsible environmental stewards: we provide homes for wildlife, protect air and water quality, and manage forests for future generations.
